### Roseneath Theatre Announces Groundbreaking 2017-18 Season

TORONTO, ON – Artistic Director **Andrew Lamb** and Managing Director **Annemieke Wade** are proud to announce Roseneath Theatre's 2017-18 Season – **Be True To You** – on today's **International Day Against Homophobia and Transphobia** ([dayagainsthomophobia.org](http://dayagainsthomophobia.org)).

Roseneath Theatre will be touring the World Premiere of ***Ladies and Gentlemen, Boys and Girls***, a new play on gender identity featuring a performer who has transitioned in the lead role. We are also thrilled to remount ***Outside***, our show that addresses homophobia and encourages Gay-Straight Alliances, which lands for a week of school performances at **Buddies in Bad Times Theatre**, as well as remounting our elementary production of ***Birds of a Feather***, that explores diversity of family – including families with two moms and two dads.

“This season we encourage our young audiences to be true to themselves and positively embrace the world around them. Through these compelling stories we invite students to reflect on their own sense of self while supporting their peers and family to be true to themselves as well. Our season's social justice and equity-themes tackle gender identity, homophobia, mental health, racism, diversity of family, Indigenous culture, bullying and more.” - Andrew Lamb, Artistic Director

The two productions rounding out our season are an eight-week US venue tour of ***The Money Tree***, which includes a week of school performances in **Las Vegas**, and the remount of our acclaimed Indigenous production of ***Spirit Horse*** which will tour Ontario schools as well as spend a week in Ottawa schools with our partners at **MASC** and two weeks in Vancouver with **Carousel Theatre for Young People**.

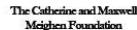
